The Club has been to Rick's before, with the last visit two years ago. For new members that are not familiar with Rick's shop, it is well worth the visit. Rick is an excellent metal fabricator. His restorations are thorough and very well done. He gives an excellent presentation and demonstration of how he does his work. It is a definite learning experience well worth your time.

The 13th of April Peter Thompson has once again agreed to host a swap meet at his garage in West Newbury, MA. This was very popular last year with many members going home with needed items for their projects. So, if you have items to sell please bring them, and if you are looking for a bargain this is the place to be.

Later in, April on Sunday the 28th, I will be leading a 1.5 hour back roads drive to the Vanilla Bean Café in Pomfret, Connecticut for lunch starting from my home in Sherborn, MA at 10 AM where we will begin with coffee and locally baked donuts. Other area drives will be available for those that want to explore on their own. We will have two group dinners and cocktail hours with two group breakfasts.

There are many other Club events scheduled in June, July, August, September and October that you will find listed on the tentative Club calendar here in the Tub Times. Most events and dates are confirmed like Greg Lane's always excellent, Connecticut tour that has been moved to the Fall on Saturday, October 5th. ODDS AND ENDS-MYSTERY RACER



TYP356ne General Operations and Guidelines

Every year we get a number of new members. It is therefore helpful to annually review the operations and guidelines of the club so everyone can get the maximum benefit for being a member. Here they are-

General Information

Website- the most up-to-date information about the Club can be found on the Club website-www.TYP356ne.org. The site will have general info, the bylaws, Club history, the schedule of events, membership info, pictures, officer information, board meeting minutes, and more. In 2018, because the old site was out of date, a new website was created. It looks completely different than the old site, but retains most, but not all, of the features of the old site. For example, the pictures of member's cars are no longer on the site. It remains a work in progress, but it is the best source of information about the Club and its activities.

Newsletter- the Club newsletter, TubTimes, is published around the first of every month and emailed to every member. It is also loaded on the website so you can view all past issues of TubTimes as well as some of the old newsletters dating back to the beginning of the Club. TubTimes will always include the full year's schedule of events and detailed information about upcoming events as well as reports on past events. Members are encouraged to send to the editor, technical articles and other information related to Porsches and automobiles in general, that may be of interest to the membership. A classified section is included for members to sell, purchase, or trade items related to our cars. Business advertisements are not allowed in the classified section or elsewhere in TubTimes. The back page lists the Club's sponsors who get a business card size ad placed in each issue. They are also listed on the website.

Flyer- the Club has produced a flyer that members can use to promote the Club. An electronic copy is attached to the email that delivered this issue of TubTimes. If you would like some printed copies that you can carry in your car to handout to prospective members, contact the newsletter editor. They are also available at Club Day and other events.

Communication

Email—One of the most useful benefits of Club membership is our email system. Any Club member can contact all members by sending an email to members@typ356ne.org. If you're not a member you cannot access that address. This is very useful tool to ask technical questions about 356s or to inform members about items or events that are related to our cars. This is an excellent way to communicate with fellow members and it is important that it only be used for Club related purposes. Members are cautioned not to include this address in other groups or in any other way that may result in unintended use.

Board Meetings– The board of directors meet monthly by conference call. All members are welcome to join in, contact the president for details. The membership can contact the board members directly by email. The website lists a Club email address for each board member that can be used by members.
